SUBJECT: Manager's Report
DATE: May 30, 2014

Parks: ** Working on cost to re-plumb the southwest area of the cemetery grounds where there's low water pressure and old galvanized pipe.

Transit: ** Six day a week service to Jack Smith Park will begin on June 2.

Finance: ** NPUA budget will go to the Board of Public Utilities on 06/03/14 for final approval, and to the NPUA on 06/10/14. General fund budget will all go before Council for final approval on 06/10/14 as well.

Engineering: ** Processing Caltrans reimbursement (I-40 Project) in the amount of \$68,137.43
** Assemblage permit for a production company filming a movie called "The Boatman" which is scheduled for June 23-25 along the river off Needles Hwy.

Utilities: ** Sanitation: Allied Waste/Republic Services will now provide service to pick up 3 extra trash bags or bundled landscaping material that cannot fit into the trash container. Landscaping material should be securely tied and shall not exceed 4 feet in length and 2 feet in width. A press release will be issued and this information will be put up on the city's website.

Greenhouse Gas (GHG) Compliance: WAPA filed the City's 2013 GHG report with the California Air Resources Board on 5/30/2014. The City electric power acquisition generated 9,118 equivalent tons of CO2 with only 4 of those tons representing renewable energy. The next step is for Locus Technologies to verify those GHG numbers.

 **** State inspection complete. Minor things to change in paper work and we will get certificate of completion.**
- Cemetery** **** Memorial Day event was held May 26. Volunteers assisted with the program and placement/removal of the flags and crosses from the veteran's gravesites.**
- Planning:** **** Processing CUP for tow/impound yard - 600 San Clemente**
 **** Processing zoning permit for Tesla charging station @ Westside Shell**
 **** Processing zoning permit for movie shoot in North Needles**
 **** Processing new business directory signage - Chester Chix/Circle K**

Code Enf:** **** Demolitions are starting and should be completed within the next week for the structures at 223 Cibola, 1229 Cherry Dr. and 415 D Street**
 **** Building is ongoing in the north Needles area with some homes being completed, garage with dwelling started and we've received plans for another new home which is going through the DRC process.**
