Fire Service Includes



- California Government Code 38611. The legislative body of a city organized under general law shall establish a fire department for the city.
- Needles City Charter Sec. 700. In addition to the council and city manager, the officers and employees of the city shall consist of city clerk, a city treasurer, a city attorney, a director of finance, a director of public utilities, a chief of police, a chief of the fire department and such other officers, assistants, deputies and employees as the council may provide by ordinance or resolution.

Fire Service is Mandated



- **Sec. 715. Chief of the fire department. The chief of the fire department shall have power and be required to:**
 - (a) Act as head of the fire department and supervise all matters relating to the prevention and extinguishing of fires and the protection of all property impaired thereby.
 - (b) Make frequent inspection of all property within the city to enforce fire prevention regulations.
 - (c) During the time of a fire exercise supreme authority over the territory involved therein, and over all persons in the immediate vicinity of the fire during such time, including policemen, who likewise shall be subject to his orders.
 - (d) Perform such other duties consistent with this Charter as may be required of him by the council.



Reduced Service Level



- \$612,451
 - 3 firefighters
 - County Fire District Prepares a Service Plan and Fiscal Analysis Report.
 - May Involve a Permanent Transfer of the City's Tax Base to the District
 - Process Takes up to One Year
 - Transfer All Equipment
 - No Fleet Replacement Fund

Annex City into County Fire District



- Mohave Valley Fire Department
 - \$1,150,000 (estimate)
 - Chief and Full Staff in Existing Station and existing equipment
- Private Provider
 - Cost and Availability Unknown at this time
- \$50,000 Fleet Replacement Fund


