____ **SIGNAL DOG** - Alerts a person with a hearing impairment to the presence of specific sounds, such as smoke/fire/clock alarms, telephone, baby crying, sirens, another person, knocks at door, unusual sounds, etc.

____ **SERVICE DOG** - Any dog individually trained to do work or perform tasks for the benefit of an individual with a disability, included or not limited to, minimal protection work, rescue work, pulling a wheelchair, or fetch dropped items.

PLEASE INCLUDE A DOCTOR'S STATEMENT OF THE OWNER'S/CUSTODIAN'S PERMANENT DISABILITY.

By affixing my signature to this affidavit, I hereby declare I fully understand that Section 365.7 of the Penal Code prohibits any person to knowingly and fraudulently representing himself or herself, through verbal or written notice, to be the owner, (authorized user), or trainer of any canine licensed as, to be qualified as, or identified as, a guide dog, signal dog, or service dog, as defined in subdivisions (d), (e), and (f), respectively, of Section 365.5 of the Penal Code and paragraph (6) of subdivision (b) of Section 54.1 of the Civil Code, and that a violation of Section 365.7 of the Penal Code is a misdemeanor,

punishable by imprisonment in a county jail not exceeding six months, by a fine not exceeding one thousand dollars (\$1,000.00), or by both imprisonment and fine.

Upon the death or retirement of an assistance dog, the owner or person in possession of the assistance dog identification tag shall immediately return the tag to the Needles Animal Control.

I declare under penalty of perjury, under laws of the State of California, that the information provided on this application is true and correct.
