

## State Route 95 Needles Bridge narrows to one-shared lane only when construction project begins Jan. 16

*Drivers should use caution and allow extra travel time*



The Arizona Department of Transportation advises drivers in the Fort Mohave AZ and Needles, CA areas to **PLAN AHEAD** for an around-the-clock lane restriction on the State Route 95 Needles Bridge beginning Monday, Jan. 16.

Temporary traffic signals will be installed and activated on the bridge beginning from **5 a.m. Monday, Jan. 16, until the end of construction in the spring:**

- The bridge will be reduced to one lane only with alternating north- and southbound travel.
- Smokestack Avenue and River Road will be closed through the end of construction.
- A vehicle-width restriction of 16 feet will be in effect.

The restrictions are needed for construction crews to safely complete the bridge rehabilitation project, which includes:

- Installing a new concrete bridge deck overlay to the existing bridge surface.
- Removing and replacing the pavement.
- Reconstructing the approach slabs.
- Replacing the bridge bearing pads and guardrail

ADOT advises drivers to **slow down** and **use caution** around personnel and equipment while construction is underway.
