

The 4 Ways to Vote

Dear Community Champion,

San Bernardino County registered voters can choose how, when, and where to vote in the 2024 Presidential Primary Election.

Here are four secure ways that registered voters can cast their ballot:

- Vote by mail by returning their voted mail ballot via the U.S. Postal Service
- Returning their mail ballot to one of more than 70 secure drop-off locations throughout the county
- Taking their mail ballot to one of our five early vote sites
- Going to their assigned polling place on March 5 to cast a ballot in person

In addition to voting by mail or at a drop-off location, the Registrar of Voters office will open for early voting beginning on Monday, February 5 from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. each weekday as well as Saturday, March 2. The Registrar of Voters office will be closed Monday, February 19 in observance of President's Day.

Four other early voting locations that include the Town of Apple Valley Recreation Center, Joshua Tree Community Center, Ontario Conference Center and Victorville City Hall will be open Tuesday, February 27 through Saturday, March 2, and on Monday, March 4, 10 a.m. to 6 p.m. These sites are closed on Sunday, March 3.

Polling places will be open from 7 a.m. to 8 p.m. on Tuesday, March 5. Voters are encouraged to vote before Election Day as polling places may have significant lines.

If a voter wants to confirm their voter registration status, they may simply visit Elections.SBCounty.gov and click on the My Elections Gateway icon.

Remember, it's "Your Ballot. Vote Early. All Ways Secure."
